Secretary Kelsey Meixner opened the meeting with the Sunshine Law Statement saying the meeting had been advertised in the Meeting Notice of February 9, 2022.

Mr. Greco made a motion to approve the January 27, 2022 Meeting Minutes seconded by Mr. Coyle and carried by a unanimous consent of members present, excluding Mr. Jones whom abstained from the vote.
