Mr. Grimm:

Mr. Grimm mentioned the passing of the former Pool Manager Bill Weigal. He passed away on May 2, 2023.

We passed the electrical inspection.

Project Graduation will be using the pool for the Senior picknick and pool party on June 12, 2023. They will be paying the lifeguards.

The slide canopy will be sent out to blanchers canvas in Dunellen. It will be replaced after 25 years.

Mr. Grimm said that he will be having a plumber come to the pool to replace all the electronic flushing valves with traditional handle flush valves.

Mr. Grimm said that the well pump has stopped working and will need to be replaced.

DeLucas Pizza will no longer be the pizza that is sold at the pool. He has reached out to the owner of DeLucas, to start purchasing pizza for the pool for the summer. The owner said that they will not be able to fulfill the order for the pool.

Mr. Grimm said that he had reached out to Craig Killian, the manager at Zupko's Tavern in Dunellen. Craig said that he will have a 10-inch pizza pie which would be the personal pizza. He will charge Mr. Grimm \$5.00 a pie, and the pool will sell it for \$8.00. Craig also said that there will be a 14-inch pizza pie. He will charge Mr. Grimm \$7.00 a pie, and the pool will sell it for \$11.00 for the whole pie or \$2.00 a slice.

Mr. Grimm said he is always willing to help the rescue squad, fire department, and police department with any of their needs for the use of the pool.
