Must maintain a room, apartment, or home on a permanent basis within the Borough of Middlesex.

#### **FAMILY MEMBERSHIP . . . . . \$280.00**

(\$260.00 if full payment received on or before April 15<sup>th</sup>) Consists of both parents/legal guardians or either of them and their children at the same address through the age of 26. (grandchildren are **not included** under "family membership".) Proof of age for all children is required for all **new** members. (Birth Certificate, Passport, Baptismal Certificate)

#### **SINGLE MEMBERSHIP . . . . . \$195.00**

( \$175.00 if full payment received on or before April 15<sup>th</sup>)  
Individuals age 14 - 61. If under 18, parent or guardian must sign application. Must be 14 by May 31, 2022.  
Proof of age required for ages 14 to 18.

#### **COUPLES/ PARENT AND ONE CHILD . . . . . \$235.00**

(\$215.00 if full payment is received on or before April 15th) Couples membership, which shall be available to two adults residing at the same residence.  
Single parent and one child, which parent shall have legal custody of the child.

#### **SENIOR CITIZEN PASS . . . . . \$50.00**

(\$45.00 if full payment received on or before April 15th) Age 62 and over. Must be 62 by May 31, 2022.  
Proof of age required for all **new** members. (Birth Certificate, Drivers License, Passport)

### Non-Middlesex Borough Residents

(A Nonresident of Middlesex Borough is anyone who does not live in the borough of Middlesex.

Ex: Dunellen, Green Brook, Piscataway, Plainfield, North Plainfield, South Plainfield.)

#### **FAMILY MEMBERSHIP . . . . . \$400.00**

(\$370.00 if full payment is received between May 1st, and May 15th.) Consists of both parents/legal guardians or both and their Children at the same address through the age of 26. (grandchildren are not **included** under "family membership".) Proof of age for all children is required for all **new** members. (Birth Certificate, Passport, Baptismal Certificate)

#### **SINGLE MEMBERSHIP . . . . . \$255.00**

(\$235.00 if full payment is received between May 1st, and May 15th.) Individuals age 14 - 61. If under 18, parent or guardian must sign application. Must be 14 by May 31, 2022. Proof of age required for age 14 to 18.

#### **COUPLES/ PARENT AND ONE CHILD . . . . . \$325.00**

(\$300.00 if full payment is received between May 1st, and May 15th.) Couples membership, which shall be available to two adults residing at the same residence. Single parent and one child, which parent shall have legal custody of the child.

#### **SENIOR CITIZEN . . . . . \$80.00**

(\$75.00 if full payment is received between May 1st, and May 15th.) Age 62 and over. Must be 62 by May 31, 2022. Proof of age required for all **new** members (Birth Certificate, Drivers, License, Passport)

If you cannot make it please find someone who can sign up your child for you on the registration day. Registrations will not be taken on Sunday or Monday.

If you do not know your child's lesson level, a water test will be given the day of registration.  
(Levels: Toddlers through Level 6)

Please bring your child in swimsuit with towel.

## **PATRON INFORMATION**

### ***Guests***

We do not limit you to the number of guests that you can bring to the pool on any day. It is important that you inform your guests of all the rules and the policies of our pool. It is important to note that we have a **NO REFUND** policy regarding our guest fees. Please keep in mind that the member is responsible for the actions of the guest.

**Guest fees:** \$10.00, 7 days a week including holidays.

### ***Birthday and Other Parties***

The pool can not be closed or rented for birthday parties; however, you may hold these parties here. The member must talk to the front office manager for instructions on how to efficiently run your party. Limit of two parties per day and one table per party. Nominal fee of \$25.00.

### ***Water Tests***

Between 12:00pm and 5:00pm, water tests for children under the age of 14 will be given during all adult swims. After 5:00pm you should seek a lifeguard who is off duty to administer the test.

### ***Hours of Operation***

Snack Bar: 12:00pm- 7:30pm

Pool: Swimming: 12:00pm - 7:50pm

Grounds: 12:00pm -8:00pm

During the month of July, the lap pool closes at 7:00pm for swim team M-F, and Wednesdays at 5:30pm when there is a home swim meet.

### ***Calendars***

The calendar has a list of all scheduled events. If there is a change in the date or time of these events, posters will be placed at the entranceway to the pool indicating the changes.

### ***Membership Cards***

The membership cards should not be discarded at the end of the pool season if you plan on joining again next year. Store them in a safe place for the winter and they will be re-validated when you send in your application and funds. A \$5.00 replacement fee per card will be charged for lost or damaged passes.

## **PATRON INFORMATION**

These pages are intended to outline and make our patrons aware of the daily procedures and policies concerning pool usage.

### ***Proper Telephone Use***

The phone number for the pool is 732-752-3366. This is the office phone and is not intended for use by the membership. If you or someone else is trying to contact someone at the pool, you may call this number and an announcement will be made over the loudspeaker. A message will be delivered to that person, but they will not be able to use the office phone to return the message.

### ***Inclement Weather***

In case of inclement weather, thunder and lightning, the procedure outlined on the bulletin board next to the first aid door will be followed. Pool will be closed for 30 minutes after the last lightning sighting.

### ***Fecal Contamination Policy***

In the event of fecal contamination or vomit, the policy which will be followed is outlined on the bulletin board next to the first aid door.

### ***Rule Enforcement***

Rule enforcement begins at home. Please make sure that you have read all rules and regulations to all members of the pool under your membership. It is the job of the Middlesex Community Pool employees to enforce every rule.

### ***Snack Bar***

Members can either purchase food at the snack bar or bring their own refreshments. Snack Bar is currently Cash Only; credit card transactions are coming soon.

**No food or drinks allowed outside of the snack bar area.**

**Alcohol is NOT permitted on pool grounds.**

**NO glass containers permitted on pool grounds.**

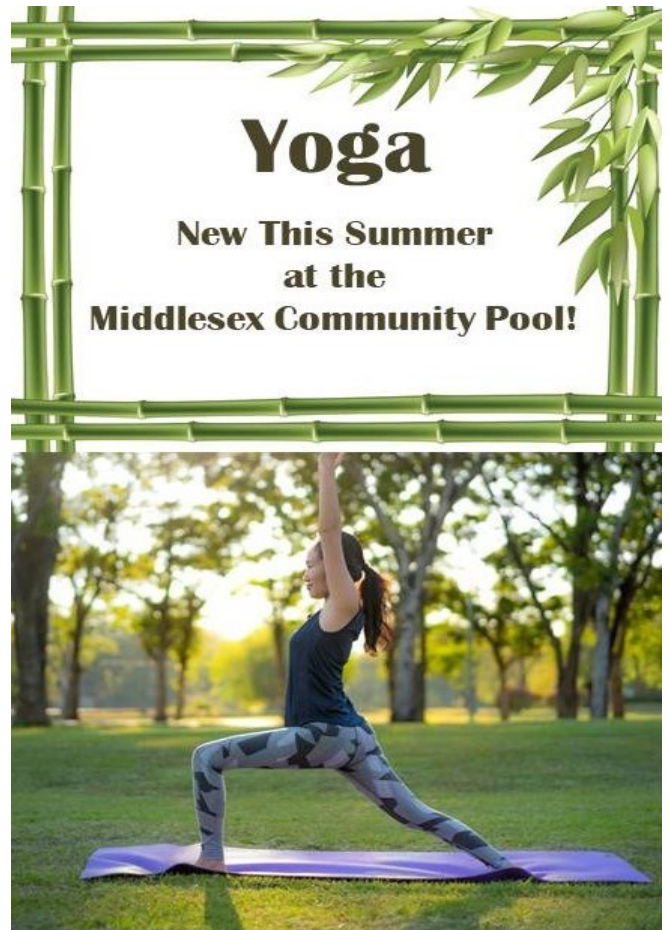

# Middlesex Community Pool

## Rules and Regulations

### Hours of Operation

- A. The pool shall be open for admission from 12 noon until 8 p.m. every day.
- B. The manager or pool supervisor may deviate from the usual hours of operation for the purpose of conducting swimming classes, permitting swim meets or other public events, or whenever, in his opinion, prevailing conditions may affect the safe use of the pool.

### General Rules and Regulations

#### A. NO PERSON IN THE POOL AREA SHALL:

1. Willfully mark, disfigure, damage, or remove any items of the property or equipment belonging to the pool area, or any signs or notices.
2. Fail to cooperate in maintaining restrooms and washrooms in a neat and sanitary condition.
3. Dispose of litter, paper, or debris except in designated trash receptacles.
4. Consume food or beverages except within designated areas.
5. Park vehicles except in designated places.
6. Have in his/her possession or consume any alcoholic beverage of any kind whatsoever.
7. Engage in any gambling activities.
8. Bring any pets or animals on the premises.
9. Park or deposit bicycles except in bicycle stalls.
10. Use or park baby carriages or strollers except in designated areas.
11. Engage in wrestling, running, ball playing or similar activities within the pool grounds.
12. Smoke on the pool grounds.
13. Engage in rough or rowdy conduct or use profane or abusive language affecting the safety, comfort, and enjoyment of other persons.
14. Enter any pool offices or equipment building without authorization.
15. Disobey any posted signs or notices

#### B. REPLACEMENT OF PASSES

1. To reissue a new pass to replace a lost or damaged pass, a fee of \$5.00 per pass will be charged.

### Special Pool Rules

#### A. NO PERSON SHALL:

1. Appear in bathing costume which does not conform to commonly accepted standards.
2. Permit infants who are not toilet-trained to be within bathing places or areas without protected diapers.
3. Dress or undress except in dressing rooms provided for that purpose.
4. Leave any chairs, cribs, umbrellas, etc. on the pool grounds. These items must be brought home each night.
5. Enter the pool area if he has had any contagious or infectious disease or condition of any nature.

6. Dive from lifeguard stands or from shoulders of another person or practice diving stunts, except within the designated area or, if under the age of 14, if he/she has not passed the prescribed pool test.
7. Enter the pool unless a lifeguard is on duty.
8. Swim in the area reserved for diving.
9. Take any toy or swimming equipment whatsoever in the mail pool.
10. Use the wading pool unless under 6 years of age.
11. Use any metal or rigid plastic toys in the wading pool.
12. Permit children or guest of a member to be left unattended in the pool complex.
13. Converse with, or distract in any manner, any lifeguard on duty.
14. Expose or offer for sale, any articles or things, or advertise in any matter, any article or service, except when permitted by the pool manager.
15. Permit children under the age of ten years, or between the ages of 10 and 14, if they have not passed the prescribed swimming proficiency test, to enter the pool area unaccompanied by a member over the age of 14.
16. Be permitted to bring a guest to the pool unless the member is 14 years of age or older, or the **guest** is 21 year of age or older. The member and the guest over 21 who brings a child to the pool must remain at the pool with the child and be responsible for the conduct and safety of the child. If a guest is asked to leave the premises of the pool for any pool violations, **NO REFUNDS** will be given and the member must leave with the guest. Guest fees are: \$8.00 weekdays, \$10.00 weekends and holidays. Infants under the age of one year admitted with no charge. There are **NO REFUNDS** for daily admissions.
17. May 31 of the current year is the cutoff date for determining a person's age for the season.

### ENFORCEMENT OF REGULATIONS

- A. The pool manager shall enforce all rules and regulations provided in this ordinance and may evict any person from the pool area for violation of any of the rules and regulations which shall be posted in a prominent place or places in the pool area.
- B. The Municipal Magistrate shall have jurisdiction over all actions and complaints for the violations of any rule or regulation provided in this ordinance. Enforcement shall be by the same proceedings and processes, and practice for the enforcement thereof and penalties shall be the same as provided in the municipal ordinance pertaining to disorderly persons.
- C. The Board of Commissioners, by a four-sevenths vote, may waive any part of the above rules when the pool is used for special events on a one or two day basis. Such waivers shall be made in writing to the Pool Manager at least one week in advance.
