PRAB (Puerto Rican Action Board) will be here 11/15 from 1pm-3pm. They will be here to assist with filing for the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). In order to be eligible, your monthly gross income for a household must be less than \$2,024 for a single person and \$2,744 for a couple. You will need to bring the following documents with you: Social Security numbers for all household members, Current utility bills (all pages), a renter's lease or homeowners' deed, and proof of current income.
