Eligibility to receive vaccines at the Middlesex County Public Health Department:

1. Children who have no insurance to cover the cost of immunizations
2. Resident of Middlesex County
3. **A \$5 fee will be assessed**

Requirements:

1. Children through age 18 only
2. Children under 7 years must have documented the first series of childhood vaccines
3. An immunization record must be brought to the clinic
4. School age children without an immunization record must have a history of having received childhood vaccines
5. Children must be accompanied by a parent
6. Children cannot be sick

From New Brunswick: From downtown New Brunswick go south on Albany Street/ French Street (Rt. 27) at the monument bear left (Jersey Ave Rt. 91). You will see a Walgreen's Pharmacy on the left continue on Jersey Ave. approx. 2 miles. The Middlesex County Public Health Department Clinic will be on your left. The building is a one story beige building with green awnings over the windows.

From Rt. 1 North or South:

Take Route 1 North or South to the Jersey Ave. (91) Exit. Follow approximately 2 miles through two lights (past How Lane) the Middlesex County Public Health Clinic will be on the right hand side of the road. The building is a one story beige building with green awnings over the windows.
