

ORDINANCE NO. 139-12

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING DOMESTIC ANIMALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESEX THAT:

WHEREAS, chickens, ducks, geese or other fowl shall not be kept for domestic use; and

WHEREAS, no person shall harbor or keep any goats, sheep, horses, non-domestic swine or cattle within the limits of the Borough unless permitted by the Borough Zoning Board or a current existing license which would be grandfathered; and

WHEREAS, no person shall maintain or harbor or permit to be maintained or harbored in any household, dwelling or dwelling unit a total of more than six (6) dogs or cats over six (6) months of age after the effective date of this Code. All domestic animals must be appropriately vaccinated and licensed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Health of the Borough of Middlesex, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey that the ordinance set herewith (1) keeping of domestic fowl is prohibited, (2) keeping of certain domestic animals is prohibited, and (3) limits the number of domestic animals.

This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
